Dear Friend,

My name is Fr. Janvier Wopoule. I was born in 1968, in Cameroon Africa, traveled to America to study at Sacred Heart Major Seminary in Detroit from 1998 to 2002. In May, 2002 I was ordained a priest at St Hugo's Parish by His Eminency

Adam Cardinal Maida. I attended Wayne State University for three years and obtained a Masters Degree in Counseling. I am now living in my home country to where I returned in February 2006.

I was born into a very poor and suffering family in a small village called Kan where I lived with my sweet mom (of loving memory) until the age of 11. My father died three months before I was born, so I grew up without any paternal affection. My big brother Laurent (I have one brother and three sisters) who was paying my primary school tuition lost his job at the end of my sixth grade year. I was doomed to become nothing, having no one to give me any support whatsoever. All of my dreams and hope for a good education and a better future were shattered.

But then God sent a person into my life, an angel, a priest by the name of Fr. Polycarpe Gilbert Ntamack, who was appointed Parish Priest at Our Lady of the Assumption Church in Kan, and who became for me a **Wellspring of Hope** for a brighter future. He made sure I went to high school seminary, then to college and university, and later supported my entry into the Major Seminary and becoming a priest.

Not actually he, but a benefactor he found for me in Europe, who was giving me this support through him. This person was my real **Wellspring of Hope**. Through her sponsorship I became who I am today.

In Africa, in Cameroon and specifically in Kan today, many children see their lives and their talents frustrated because there's no one to help. You can make the difference in the life, and put a smile on the face of one or two of these children by becoming a sponsor. Many have started doing it through the Wellspring of Hope Foundation, and the lives of many children in Kan are being transformed thanks to their generous support. Why not you?
